Words from Bro. Scott:

The Bible records an interesting fact about Easter in Matthew 28:11-15. After Jesus rose from the grave, the priests and elders paid a large sum of money to the soldiers who had guarded the tomb to lie about the resurrection. They lied to try and stop people from believing that Jesus was alive. Now if a huge stone couldn't stop the resurrection, stationed soldiers couldn't stop the resurrection, and death itself couldn't stop the resurrection, then the priests and elders had a problem. Jesus was alive! He appeared to Peter, the twelve disciples, over 500 believers, James and all the apostles, and Paul. (1 Cor. 15:5-8)

Nothing can stop God's plan through the resurrection, and the message we must continue to proclaim:
Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave, so we can have life here on earth and in eternity!

If Jesus hadn't come out of the grave, what would be the point of preaching and teaching? The hope that we share would be empty—a lie. The gospel itself is founded on Christ's victory over sin, death, hell and the grave. Because He rose, there's a reason to share the good news! Paul shares this exact message with the Corinthians, and builds the church in Corinth on this same foundation. We see in this Scriptural passage that there's not hope to be had in a dead Jesus. Other belief systems place their hope, in part, on men who are now deceased. However, the difference in our faith is that we place our hope in a Savior who is no longer dead, but who defeated death! The resurrection is what sets Christianity apart from every other belief system. Our hope is the only truly lasting, eternal one, precisely because He walked out of that grave. Jesus is supreme because He is the only one who has conquered death, hell and the grave. If He had not done this—if there was no resurrection—we could be wasting our time believing in and following Jesus. Thank God for the hope we have in Jesus because of the resurrection!

“And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain” 1 Corinthians 15:14

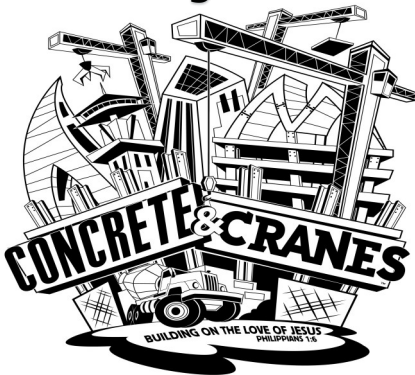

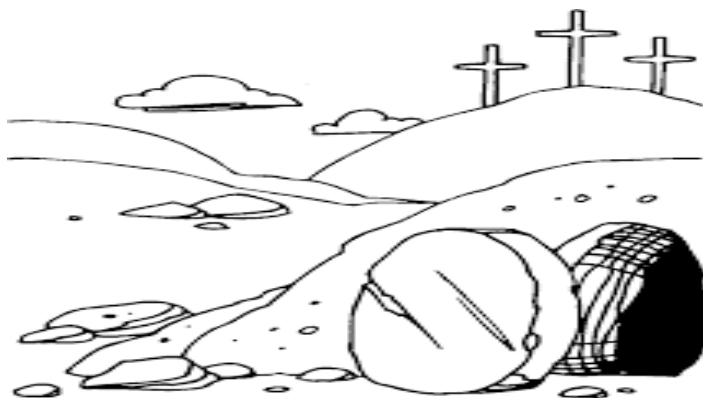
