The great Apostle Paul wrote, "But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God."
Acts 20:24 KJV

Paul is stating that nothing can shake him or turn him away from his faith in Jesus. Paul had died to self. His life didn't count. Paul felt he was the worst of sinners but God forgave him and even called him to minister the gospel. Paul knew first-hand the saving grace of Jesus. He hurt Jesus, he hurt the church but Jesus forgave him, called him, and used him to win the lost and build the very church he tried to destroy. Paul was eternally grateful to Jesus and His saving grace. His life belonged to the Lord, and the Lord could do with it as He so desired. This is us. We are born again, set apart, and commissioned by Jesus to tell others the glorious news of the gospel.
