"My heart, O God, is steadfast, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and make music." *Psalms 57:7 (NIV)*

David wrote this Psalm from a cave during the time that he was running for his life from King Saul. It doesn't seem like the time or place to speak of being steadfast, especially while he was literally living in a cave, with no home, no security, or stability to speak of. The word steadfast means to be fixed, firm, stable, secure and settled.

Reading this Psalm you'll discover that David's feelings are often anything but steadfast. He is always honest about his emotions to God. In just a few verses he can go from sadness to celebration, from fear to faith, from loathing to love, so when David says his heart is steadfast, I don't think he is talking about a feeling. I believe he is telling God about a decision he has made deep within himself. He is really saying, "No matter how I feel, no matter what is going on around me, I've chosen to love you, God. My heart is settled on that matter." Then David says, "I will sing and make music!" This tells us that being steadfast in God is not about trying harder to love Him. Being steadfast is more like singing praises to Him. It's a decision to rest in God and find joy in Him in every circumstance.

Our security does not come from anywhere or anyone but God!


